BHMS Industry Training

Industry Training is an integral part of the study program at BHMS. During each academic year, students are normally required to successfully complete a 4-6 months Industry Training period in a hospitality business approved by BHMS. Internship Placement Managers assist students with placements in hotels and restaurants both in Switzerland and overseas. During the Industry Training, students will be under L-GAV contractual obligation with their employers, which will entitle them to receive a trainee's gross monthly salary of **CHF2,179** if undertaken in Switzerland. While

no tuition fees are due to BHMS during this period, employers make deductions for room, board and taxes equivalent to ca. CHF700-900 on a monthly basis. To qualify for industry training, students are expected to meet specific academic, professional, and language skills standards set forth by BHMS. During industry placement, students' performance, behaviour and professional attitude will be assessed by employers and students are required to submit a report about the nature and management of the property in which they had their industry training.
